Van Divner moved, MacGregor seconded, PASSED, to appoint Troup to Cemetery Committee. (5-0)

Cemetery Committee will meet on June 12, 2018 at noon.

Van Divner moved, Major seconded, PASSED by unanimous roll call vote, to approve and adopt the Great Lakes Energy franchise ordinance for 30 years, Friendship Township Ordinance 2018-01. The franchise provides authorization for Great Lakes Energy to provide electric and other services by running of lines, poles, and other apparatus that are necessary to provide electricity and broadband service to Township residents in the public right-of-way.

Major reviewed bills and checks.

Public Comment – Craig Antoine from Maple River Township introduced himself as a candidate for county commissioner on the Republican ticket.

Van Divner moved, Ward seconded, PASSED by unanimous roll call vote, to approve payment of the bills. Checks # 3967-3990 were written in the amount of \$12,711.50.
