Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by supervisor. Pledge of allegiance recited.
Board members present: Major, Mac Gregor, Troup and Van Divner. Ward absent.

Minutes of March 28 meeting stood approved as presented.
No Treasurer's report.

Board reviewed insurance coverage information for upcoming year.
-Major moved, Mac Gregor seconded, PASSED, to approve payment of \$3,137 invoice to
Burham and Flower Insurance Group for township insurance covering May 11, 2018 – May 10,
2019.

Great Lakes Energy Ordinance for Grant of Franchise for operating within the public right of
way for provision of electric services and broadband services for a period of 30 years was
presented to the board. There will be a public hearing on the proposed ordinance on June 6 at
7:00 at the beginning of the regular board meeting after which the board will consider the
adoption of the ordinance.

Alanson Area Library is launching a mobile library project this summer. They plan to set up here
at Friendship Township Hall for three hours each week. More details will be furnished. Board
has no objection. Troup offered to be at the town hall during that time each week.

Mac Gregor reviewed checks and bills.
