Mac Gregor moved, Major seconded, PASSED, to approve Emmet County Interlocal Agreement for County Designated Assessor and authorized supervisor to sign. (5-0)

Clerk received a letter from Keller Caretaking to continue snow removal services for the 20/21 winter season at a rate of \$42 per time. Board has no objection to continuing to use Keller Caretaking at the new rate.

Election – There were 698 voters for the November 3rd election which was 77% of registered voters.

The board extends a big thank you to Al Major for his sixteen years of service on the board as a trustee!! He will be greatly missed.

The board also extends condolences to the Kurburski family in the loss of their father, Wilbur Kurburski. Wilbur served as sexton and caretaker for Friendship Township for at least the last 34 years.
