BOARD MEETING

Meeting called to order by Troup at 7:00 pm. Pledge of allegiance recited.

Board members present: Van Divner, Ward, Troup, Mac Gregor, Major.

Agenda approved as written.

Minutes of the August 7 meeting stood approved as presented.

Treasurer's report received.

Troup reported he had contacted our township attorney regarding the need for an ordinance to opt out of the recreational marijuana facilities. We need an ordinance and it will be ready to present at our October 2 meeting.

Road work has been completed, which includes overlay of Lower Shore Drive and seal coat of Five Mile Creek Road and cutoff at south end of West Townline Road.

A letter from three S. Lamkin Road residents was presented to the board requesting a survey of residents of the road regarding paving. Troup will write a letter explaining the costs and the township's limited funds to accomplish such a project.

There will be a county-wide ballot issue November 5 for millage for the Emergency Medical Services (EMS).

Van Divner moved, Mac Gregor seconded, PASSED by unanimous roll call vote, to approve payment of the bills. Checks # 4264-4282 were written in the amount of \$52,455.91.
