Van Divner moved, Mac Gregor seconded, PASSED, to approve Assessor Contact Policy.

Emmet County Case # PSUP22-007
Van Divner moved, Negley seconded, PASSED, to recommend approval of request for Special Use Permit to move shipping container to back side of accessory building,

Zoning Variance request – parcel 06 12 13 400 007
Mac Gregor moved, Cullip seconded, PASSED, to follow Friendship Township Planning Commission's recommendation of approval with stipulation that affidavit be filed as indicated in owner's application which states that only the owners will be using the property for a limited time – 7 times, maximum 60 days – per year and camping trailers will not be on property when not in use.

Tunnel of Trees meeting will be held at Friendship Township hall on Tuesday, June 13th at 9:30 am.

Mac Gregor moved, Van Divner seconded, PASSED, to request contract with Emmet County Road Commission to wedge Terpening Road from M119 north 3,500 feet at a cost of \$54,300 for materials only, with Emmet County Road Commission supplying labor and equipment.

Comments were received from several residents of South Lamkin Rd who are interested in having the road paved as they believe the current road condition is a safety issue.

Cullips reviewed checks and bills.

Van Divner moved, Cullip seconded, PASSED by unanimous roll call vote, to approve payment of the bills. Checks # 5135 through 5151 were written in the amount of \$89,479.66.
